

## **EVENT POLICIES & FAQ**

### **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES & DRUGS**

These are absolutely not permitted on the grounds and those found under the influence of, or in possession of such will be escorted off the property, and/or, turned over to the law enforcement officials.

### **BOOTH CLOSING**

The booth and food areas will close approximately ½ half hours during the final performance 8:00 P.M. – 10:00 P.M. so that everyone can attend.

### **BOOTHS & MUSIC**

alloutpraise! will offer the convenience of many Christian ministry booths. Each performing artist will also have the ability to host a booth selling their music & other merchandise. ### **CAMERAS**

Regular cameras are permitted at alloutpraise! However, any professional camera equipment (including tripods, cameras with removal lenses, etc.) and video recording devices are NOT (without special written consent from the alloutpraise! staff! Photos must be taken from wherever you will be standing/sitting during the performances. This is agreed upon by alloutpraise! and the performing artist to protect the artists' rights. Thank you for your cooperation.

### **CHILDREN**

Lost children should be taken to security. Please keep children beside you at all times! Children must be accompanied by at least one adult at all times.

### **DRESS CODE**

Leaders, chaperones, and parents: We need your help in enforcing this policy our staff will appreciate it! MODESTY is the key word. While the style and fashion these days seem to be "less is best," we do not want to be guilty of causing another person to stumble. Bathing suits are NOT permitted. Tank tops are fine but bellies must be covered. Shorts and/or skirts need to be long enough and shirts big enough. Shirts and shoes MUST be worn by all at all times.

### **NO FRISBEES, FOOTBALLS, OR OTHER GAME ACTIVITIES ARE PERMITTED!**

### **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR BEVERAGES PERMITTED.**

Sorry, in order to provide this event as such a low cost to the public, the Center is holding all food sales as a way to help provide funds for the Center's ministry. Any packs, backpacks, etc. will be checked by Security as a way of not only honoring this policy, but helping to keep this event a safe and great place to worship God and fellowship with each other!

### **GOLF CARTS AND MOTOR VEHICLES**

No individual golf carts or other motor vehicles (other than motorized wheelchairs) are permitted, the only golf carts allowed are those in use for the alloutpraise! staff.

### **LITERATURE DISTRIBUTION**

Literature distribution is only permitted from official booths located in the permitted areas, regardless of type of literature. Please understand that this rule will be strictly enforced.

## **LITTER**

Please help keep the grounds clean by picking up any trash that you spot and deposit it in the nearest trash can. Please notify the main booth of any overflowing trash cans.

## **LOST & FOUND**

All lost and found items should be taken to, or retrieved from the alloutpraise!'s lost and found, located at the main booth. Any valuable items (i.e., cameras, phones, jewelry, glasses, medication, keys, etc.) that are turned into Lost & Found and are not claimed at the concert will be brought to the Christian Family & Children's Center-North Campus office. ## **PARKING, SHUTTLES & TRANSPORTATION**

A FREE parking space is available for you to park your cars. NO buses or other commercial vehicles permitted without prior notice. Please follow the instructions of the parking attendants by parking where they direct you. Please lock your vehicles as we are not responsible for damage done to the vehicle while parked at our facilities. Shuttles are available for participants who are parking in the overflow parking lot, approximately ¼ mile East on Route 31. If you are walking to your car, please watch for traffic, and use road sides only for walking. Please help us honor our neighbors by not utilize their property for shortcuts!

***Handicapped Parking:*** Handicapped parking must be done with an appropriate handicapped placard. Dropping for people not designated as handicapped, but having difficulty walking may be done at the designated area to the North side of the field. See facility marking signs.

## **PETS**

Pets are NOT allowed on the grounds, including the parking areas. Please make arrangements with a nearby kennel (or family members) to care for your pet while you are gone. If you require the assistance of a seeing-eye dog, please contact alloutpraise! before the event to make the appropriate arrangements.

## **SEATING**

Seating is lawn seating. First come/First Serve. There will be no pushing or shoving to get to the front of the stage. You may sit in any open spot. Please be courteous to those around you. Do not carry on long conversations inside the seating area. Umbrellas or other shade protective devices are required to be in the rear section of the lawn. (Please follow designated signs)

## **TOILETS**

Toilet facilities are placed throughout the grounds. Please notify a staff member if they need servicing. We need everyone's cooperation in keeping these facilities as clean as possible.

## **WEATHER CONDITIONS**

alloutpraise! will be held RAIN or SHINE! Please pack & dress appropriately. Umbrellas are permitted, but you MAY NOT block the view of other observers who wish not to use an umbrella. Please stand toward the back!

## **IN/OUT PRIVILEGES**

You are permitted to exit the facility and re-enter. Please limit this in and out privilege. You must enter and exit through security. Please keep your ticket stub as proof of entry. Wristbands or stamping devices will be given upon entry and must be present upon re-entry. This rule is extremely important for public safety.

## FIRST AID CENTER

A first aid center will be on the grounds. If you have special medical needs, please register at the medical center upon arrival. Each underage registrant must have his/her parent or a guardian sign a "Consent to Treat" form.

**Note concerning electric wheelchairs:** Due to the limited amount of electrical hookups we are unable to recharge wheelchairs. If you have a wheelchair that will need to be recharged, you should provide your own generator. In an emergency situation, the security office may be able to assist you.

## GROUND

Please do not go into un-designated areas on Campus grounds. Nobody without a backstage pass will be permitted in the backstage area (no exceptions).

## WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS

There will be wireless internet access availability on Harr field and in the surrounding area. This access is unsecured, but is monitored by the Center's Proxy Server Filtering Software. You must check your internet connection options to use a proxy server, and designate 192.168.2.7 as the Proxy.

## Alloutpraise! Q & A

Q: Are tickets transferable?

A: Yes, ticket(s) can be sold and used by another party.

Q: What if I need additional tickets for alloutpraise!

A: Simply order additional tickets by phone, online, or at the gate!

Q: I am bringing a group and I have many questions on what I will need and what to expect. What can you tell me to help me prepare?

A: Check out the maps & other notices of interest in the "Welcome Brochure" that will be given upon entry.

Q: Do you have a scheduled time when the artists are performing?

A: We will not have a schedule until approximately two weeks prior to the event. It will be published online as soon as we do and will be provided in the Welcome Brochure!

Q: Do you just sit anywhere?

A: You will sit in the main field area or any area marked off for seating! Seats are first come/first serve. No reserving or saving spots!

Q: Can I bring an umbrella or large shade protection?

A: Yes, you may use shading devices, however, you will have to be in the rear section of the lawn (follow designated signs).

Q: What about joining in the singing, standing, clapping, etc.!

A: By all means, please enjoy the day, the bands, and each other. Please do respect your neighbors on the field and be considerate. This event does represent the broad spectrum of the Body of Christ, so enjoy yourself, but be careful to not cause others to fall!
